- 3. Will it build GOODWILL & BETTER FRIENDSHIPS?
- 4. Will it be BENEFICIAL to all concerned?

Essay Contest Rules

- 1. The essay contest is open to all seventh grade students at Park View Middle School.
- 2. The essay shows a true understanding of the meaning of the 4-Way Test
- 3. The essay should be based upon a personal life or school experience
- 4. The essay should discuss the significance and relevance of the 4-Way Test in developing a life of high values and moral character (both personally and professionally)
- 5. The essay must be three to five hundred (300-500) words in length
- 6. Entries must be submitted to the Language Arts Staff by 04/01/2019 and to the South Hill Rotary Club by 04/05/19.
