**NOMINATION PROCESS
2016 - 2017**

The ***“Tom Leggett Spirit of Rotary Award”*** is to be given annually to a member of South Hill Rotary Club who has been a member for five years or less and who, through his or her actions, has embraced the concept of Rotary, demonstrated a commitment to Rotary ideals, and has become actively involved in the South Hill Rotary Club. Candidates must be nominated by a member of this club and members may not nominate themselves.

Nominations may be made anytime during the club year in which the award will be presented, but must be received by the committee no later than **5:00 pm on Friday, April 28, 2017**. E-mailed nominations are acceptable, but the above-mentioned timing must be adhered to.

Nominees must be current members of South Hill Rotary Club in good standing at the time the award is bestowed. Nominees must fit the longevity of membership in the Club described above.

Nominees should exemplify the tenets and intents of Rotary, including ***“Service Above Self”*** and the ***“4-Way Test.”*** Specific contributions to the club and the community in one or more of the four Avenues of Service must be addressed in the nomination.

Service Above Self Committee and Process

The Service Above Self Committee will review nominations for this award and the other two awards (S. A. S. Individual and S. A. S. Business) to be given at the same time and submit the nominees to the Board of Directors for its approval at the **May 2017** Board meeting.

The committee shall consist of at least three members appointed by the current President. For all awards from 2012 on, the committee will consist of the chair person, the current recipient of the award, one general member of the club and a past president.

The committee will screen all applications for: timely receipt and specific qualifications of the nominee. The committee will then recommend this year's honoree from among all eligible nominees to the South Hill Rotary Club Board for its approval. The deliberations of the committee and the list of nominees and the honoree are to be held in strict confidence.

Award

The winner of the ***“Tom Leggett Spirit of Rotary Award”*** will receive: a framed certificate and/or a trophy.
